9. To maintain good relations, out of mutual respect, with the Institute staff (the Principal, teaching and non-teaching personnel) and parents.


Roles of the Members of the Student Council

- To take part in all special committees formed by the council or send a representative to such committees.
- To represent the students on official occasions.
